

VISION OR BIBLE

On or about January 1, 1984, Gordon Lewis Ziegler had an extensive vision in a motel room in Salt Lake City Utah that lasted about an hour and a half. Gordon was aware that his vision was given by none other than Lucifer (the devil or Satan), but it had the convincing ring of truth to it. For years in close study, Gordon could not determine if it was some kind of beautiful elaborate deception or if were wholly Biblical. It looks like it is wholly Biblical and the truth of God. But you be the judge. In the chart below the teachings of the vision and the teachings of the Bible are contrasted.

Vision	Bible
The Everlasting Father God left His throne and incarnated a baby son.	Isaiah 9:5-7: The Mighty God, the Everlasting Father would be born a child, a son. This has been applied to the Son of God Jesus, but it fits more naturally The Everlasting Father God Himself.
The throne of the Universe was turned over to Lucifer.	Ezekiel 28:2: An alien person would sit on the throne of God, showing himself that he is God. This would be for an extended time while God's incarnation would live out his life on earth.
The incarnation of the Everlasting Father was after the fire holocaust battle of the atomic bombs on Hiroshima and Nagasaki, Japan, August 6 and 9, 1945.	Isaiah 9:5, 6; Zephaniah 1:7-8; 2 Peter 3:10-12.
The incarnation of the Everlasting Father would someday sit on the throne of David his father.	Isaiah 9:6, 7.

Vision

The anointed one's rule would not be limited to earth.

The incarnation of the Everlasting Father will raise and heal people through a machine. The vision called Gordon the very Christ.

The vision called Gordon the Anointed One and Messiah.

The vision called Gordon my Servant the BRANCH.

The vision called Gordon the stone which the builders rejected, which has become the head of the corner.

The vision called Gordon Wonderful, Counselor, the Mighty God, the Everlasting Father, the Prince of Peace.

Bible

Isaiah 9:6, 7.

John 5:21; 1 Corinthians 15:22. The Father raises people as well as the Son. Whoever raises people from the dead is properly called Christ.

The Anointed One, Messiah, and Christ are all synonyms. No separate texts are needed to substantiate the Anointed One and Messiah.

Zechariah 6:12-13. The prophecy speaks of "them both" when referring to the BRANCH.

Psalms 118:22; Isaiah 28:16. Jesus is the foundation corner stone; there is another stone that becomes the head of the corner.

Isaiah 9:6. That goes with the Everlasting Father incarnate.
